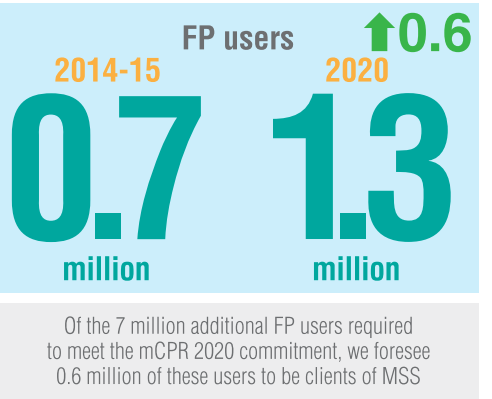
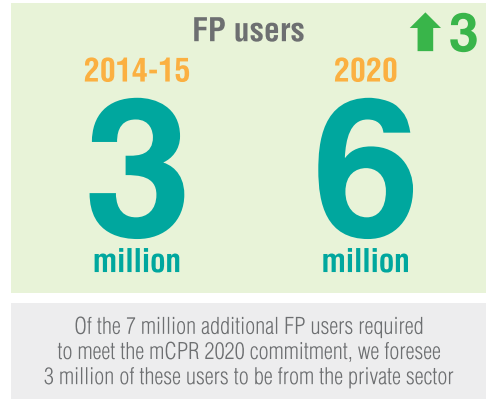
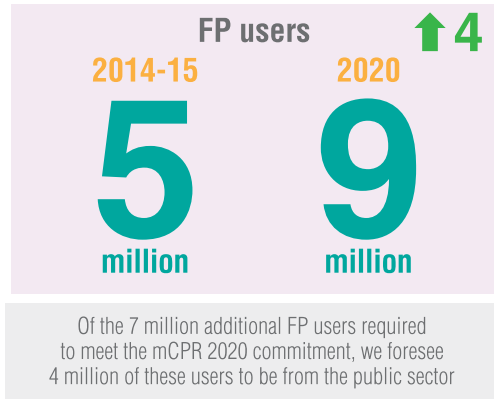
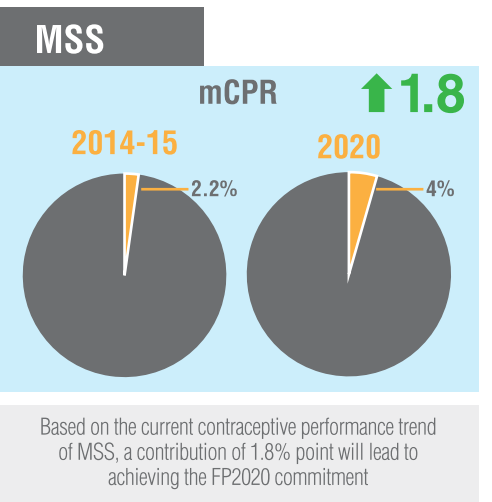
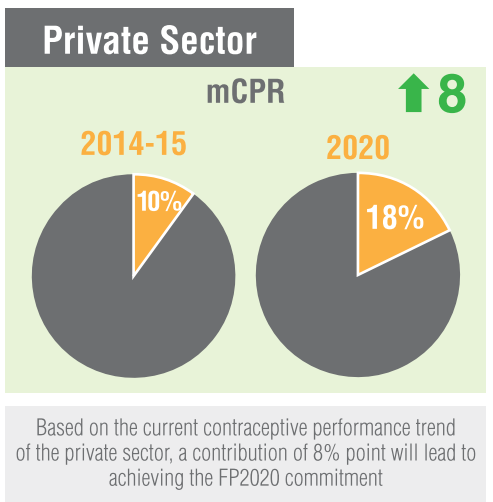
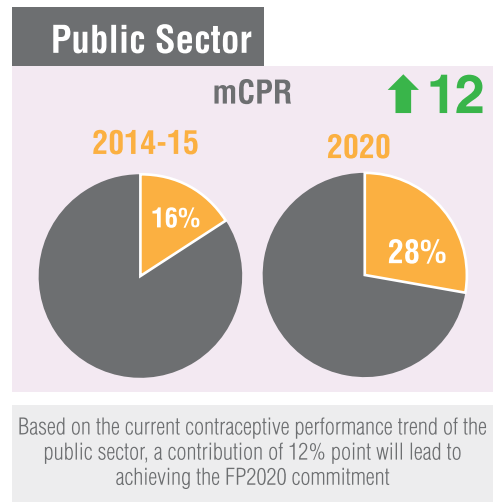
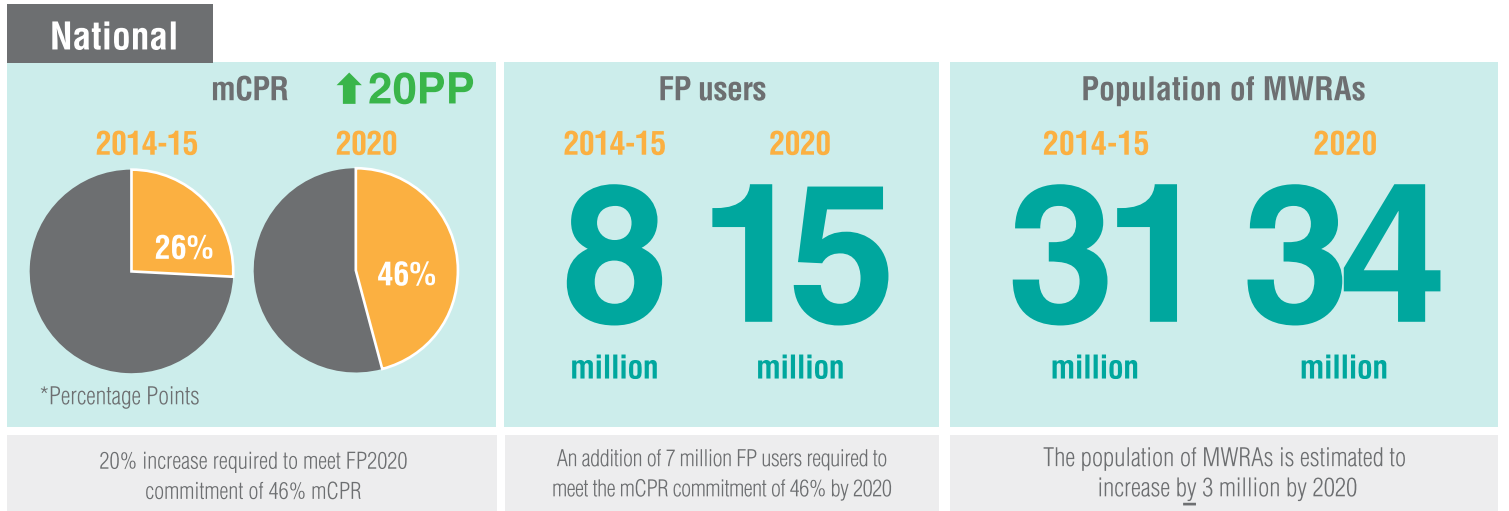
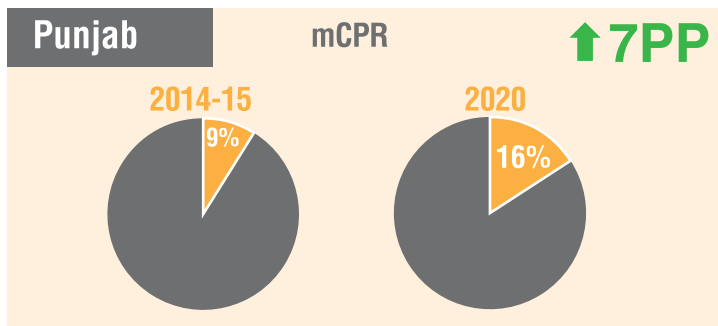


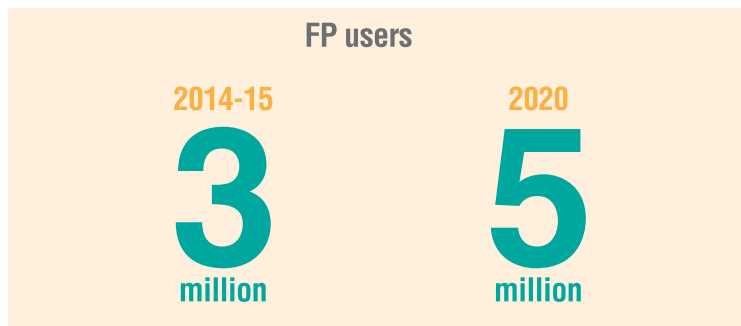
# FP2020 Commitments and Projections

At the London 2012 Summit, Pakistan committed to achieving a CPR\* OF 55% by 2020 of which we assume the modern methods would be 45%, if the traditional methods were to remain at 9%. The following brief summarizes the contribution to CPR that public and private sectors, and each province will have to make in order for Pakistan to achieve the 2020 target. It also presents the minimum essential contribution to numbers of new FP users and modern CPR that Marie Stopes Society must make by 2020 to achieve the overall FP2020 goal of achieving 55% CPR.

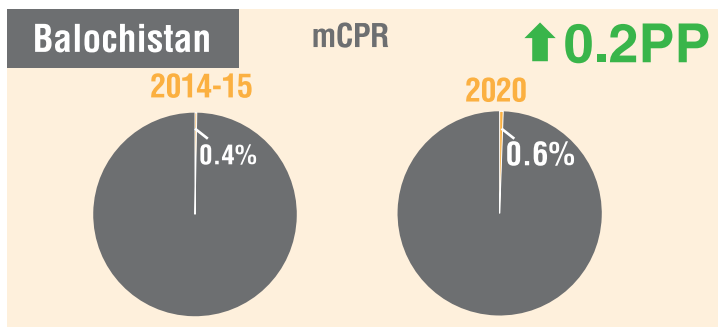




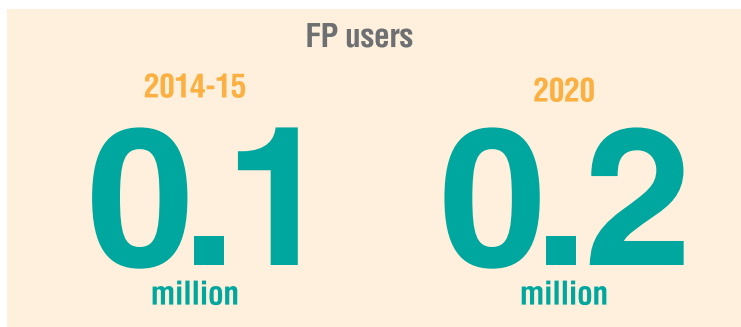
