

National Contraceptive Performance of the Years 2013-14 and 2014-15

Summary of Findings of the Contraceptive Performance Report, Government of Pakistan – Statistics Division, Pakistan Bureau of Statistics

The overall CPR by modern methods during 2014-15 was 25.54%, decreasing from 27.41% in 2013-14. All provinces witnessed a decrease in the CPR except for Balochistan, where CPR increased from 6.73% in 2013-14 to 6.93% in 2014-15. It is to be noted that Islamabad had the highest CPR of 41.36% during 2014-15.

In 2014-15, method-wise comparison showed an increase of 227.5% in the uptake of Norplant, whereas a decrease of 6.7%, 7.3%, 9.3%, 4.8%, and 5.4% was observed in the uptake of Condoms, Oral Pills, IUDs, Injectables, and Contraceptive Surgeries, respectively.

Overall, CYPs decreased 7.2% between 2013-14 and 2014-15 due to shortage of technical staff, low clientage due to severe weather conditions, insufficient contraceptive availability, and poor performance. Significant increase in AJK was attributed to availability of medicines and increased frequency of mobile camping.

RFAP witnessed an increase of 15.8% in performance due to skill-based training and refreshers of more than 100 service providers on comprehensive package of modern contraceptive methods, with a focus on long-term permanent methods. Significant increase in the performance of Marie Stopes Society (MSS) for 2014-15 over 2013-14 was due to a rapid increase in the number of Social Franchise Clinics, Field Health Educators, community-based Private Providers (PK Providers), and Mobile Outreach Camps. Significant decrease in performance of Greenstar Social Marketing (GSM) for 2014-15 over 2013-14 was due to the restructuring of its network, a stagnation in Interpersonal Communication (IPC) activities during the period, and a halt in community-level demand generation activities.
